



Frequently Asked Questions

My athlete has another tryout at the same time, right before or right after your tryout, what do we do?

This happens frequently as a result of the way the tryout process is run in Badger Region. Unfortunately there is not much we can do. We cannot offer a personal tryout or schedule an individual time for any player. Our best recommendation is to attend as much of all tryouts as you can.

Should I try out for a specific position or show up regardless if I know what position I should try out for?

When you check in, there will be sheets that you can write down your preferred position. We will take what you write down into consideration, but we will use the tryout as an overall evaluation of all your abilities. Once the season starts, you will play based on your strengths and what is best for you and the team.

When do you begin picking teams?

The team selection process begins immediately after tryouts. Our coaching staff begins reviewing evaluations and forming teams that day. Phone calls to players begins as soon as possible. Because so many calls need to be made, some athletes may get a phone call right after tryouts, while others may get a phone call later. If you do not hear from us on the day of tryouts, this DOES NOT mean you will not be offered a spot on our teams. Even if others have received a call. Please be patient as we get through calls.

When are practices?

Teams practice 2 nights per week for 90 minutes. Practice schedule subject to change based on tryout results and team selections. Practices will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4:30 pm - 6 pm OR 6 pm - 7:30 pm at the Community First Champion Center.

Did you do retention offers?

Wisconsin Blaze participated in a limited capacity in the retention period window. We offered a small amount of retention offers. Almost all positions are open on all of our teams.

How many players are on a team?

Teams are generally made up of roughly 10-12 players. It is up to the coaches discretion how many players they would like to send offers to.

What can be expected in terms of playing time?

Coaches are expected to only make offers to players that they intend to give playing time to. Although we can not guarantee "equal" playing time among all players, we can guarantee "fair".

What tournaments will be played?

Our teams practice in a variety of tournaments depending on their level. Our Regional teams will play in more local, one day tournaments and Badger Region Championships. Our Midwest teams will play in tournaments in Wisconsin but more two day tournaments like Prep Dig, JVA, Badger Region Championships. Our National teams will play in more competitive two day tournaments in Wisconsin and out of state including Prep Dig, JVA, a qualifier and a national tournament (USAV or AAU).
